Clun Memorial Hall 200 Club

Hello and welcome to the launch of our new fund-raising scheme, designed not only to benefit your Memorial Hall but also to give each subscriber the chance to win one of six valuable cash prizes every month. A win-win situation!

It is called a 200 Club because once fully subscribed, it will consist of 200 supportive members who recognise the community value of the Memorial Hall facility and who are willing to commit a small sum each month, to help place it on a firmer financial footing going into the future.

Each member pays £5 per month by bank standing order. The Memorial Hall charity retains 50% into its funds and 50% is placed into a monthly draw. Assuming 200 members, the prizes will be:

1 @ £200, 1 @ £100, 2 @£50 and 2 @ £25. £50 will be retained each month to provide additional prizes in the December draw each year. If there are fewer than 200 members, then the prizes will be reduced pro-rata to maintain the 50/50 division of the funds contributed.

The scheme will have several direct benefits to the Memorial Hall Charity:

- It will contribute substantially towards our fixed overhead costs and so alleviate the regular cash flow concern of what can be spent each month on ongoing maintenance issues.
- It will help us raise further seed grant funding, which in turn will provide valuable support to any grant application which we may make for future capital projects. A funder will always look more favourably upon a proposal, where:
 - the applicant can make some financial contribution and
 - community support can be clearly demonstrated, as they know that their further support will be wisely spent improving a valued facility.
- Finally, it will in due course help us to raise the profile of the hall. A facelifted hall fit for the 21st century, will enable us to realise its potential, particularly as a function and concert venue, and that is to the benefit of everyone in the locality.

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So, please support our endeavour and join today. Enclosed are the full Terms and Conditions relating to the scheme but should you still have further questions, then we will be pleased to answer them for you.


In order to proceed, please complete and return the enclosed application form to the hall secretary, at the address below. Please ensure that you complete all sections and sign it.

The scheme is not available to anyone under the age of 16. Anyone under 21 must provide their date of birth where indicated.

Once your application has been accepted you will be issued with a lottery number and sent a bank standing order authority for signature and onward transmission to your bank. The lottery number will remain unchanged for every draw. You may apply for more than one number, should you wish.
