## Clun Memorial Hall 200 Club Terms and Conditions

- The "200 Club" is operated as a Small Society Lottery, under a licence granted by Shropshire County Council – Registration No. 22/03172/SSLR
- 2. The promoter is the Chair of the Clun & District Memorial Hall & Playing Fields Charity (CMH).
- 3. The monthly subscription will be £5.00 per lottery number, to be paid only by bank standing order, monthly. More than one lottery number may be purchased by a subscriber at additional cost, if desired. Lottery numbers, once allocated remain constant unless the subscriber they are allocated to, withdraws from the scheme. In which case they will be re-allocated to a new subscriber.
- 4. The Club "year" will run from 1st January to 31st December.
- 5. Once the scheme has 200 members, it will be fully subscribed.
- 6. Annual prize money will equate to 50% of the total contributed over the year. The Memorial Hall Charity will retain the balance in order to support its charitable activities.
- 7. The monthly prizes will be: 1st Prize: 20% of contributions (this will be the first number drawn) 2nd Prize: 10% of contributions. Two 3rd Prizes of 5% each of contributions and two prizes of 2.5% each of contributions. 5% of contributions will be retained to fund additional prizes in the December draw.
- 8. No person under the age of 16 may purchase a ticket or take part in the lottery.
- 9. Subscribers must apply to join the scheme by completing an application form and agree to complete a bank standing order mandate for the payment of the subscription.
- 10. The draws will be conducted at a public venue, which will be advertised beforehand, at the beginning of each month. Winners of prizes will be notified by text or email, and the results published in the Clun Chronicle, on the Clun Valley Facebook page and on the CMH website.
- 11. No "200 Club" participant will be included in the draw if the appropriate subscription has not been received by the last day of the month preceding the one in which the draw is taking place. The Promoter reserves the right to reallocate any number where payment has not been received on time.
- 12. Prizes will be paid only to the person holding the winning number and will be made by direct bank transfer to the bank and account number stated on the standing order mandate for that person.
- 13. Subscribers must notify the Promoter in writing of any change of address or bank details. It is the responsibility of the Subscriber to ensure this is done promptly. Neither the Charity, it's Trustees, nor the Promoter can be held liable for funds going astray, where such notifications have not been made promptly.
- 14. Subscribers can cancel their entry in the Lottery at any time by giving one month's written notice to the Promoter (they should also advise their bank to cancel the standing order instruction).
- 15. No subscriptions will be refunded.
- 16. The Board of Trustees of the CMH charity will determine any dispute and their decision shall be final.
- 17. The rights conferred by membership, including the right to participate in the monthly draw, may not be transferred to a third party.
- 18. The Board of Trustees of the CMH charity reserve the right to amend the number and amount of individual prizes from time to time, whilst remaining compliant with Clause 6 above. A copy of the current rules is available from the Promoter and on the CMH website at: www.clunmemorialhall.co.uk
- 19. Any decision by the Board of Trustees to wind up the Club will be subject to giving three month's public written notice in the Clun Chronicle.
